



## MEĐUGORJE

Pilgrimage Međugorje is a unique event in the modern world. It is believed the Our Lady appeared in front of a group of children in 1981. Thanks to Our Lady apparitions this simple village parish has become a place of gathering for a multitude of pilgrims from the whole world and one of the biggest prayer centres in the world. You will have the opportunity to visit the Apparition Hill and attend Mass in the local church.

**Duration:** Full day excursion to Bosnia Herzegovina

## NERETVA RIVER DELTA & ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE "NARONA"

The Neretva river delta is a completely untouched natural environment offering shelter for numerous birds, fishes, citrus trees, fruits, vegetables and other species. It is an experience to drive through this jewel of nature. Not without reason the Romans had a settlement in this area. The remains of the ancient city of Narona is situated at the place that we now call the village of Vid near Metkovic. Narona was a Roman colony and emporium and its massive wealth based on trade. Archaeological digs provided epochal results, with the discovery of Augusteum.

**Duration:** Full day excursion

**Included:** Services of English/French/Dutch speaking private driver, pick up and drop off in front of your hotel, ride through the Delta of river Neretva by car, optional visit of the archaeological site of Narona. Passport required.



## TRSTENO BOTANICAL GARDEN

The village Trsteno, located at 20km northwest of Dubrovnik is famous for the gigantic plane tree of more than 500 years old. Arboretum Trsteno is the oldest botanical garden of Croatia. Established at the end of the 15th century as a summer residence for the Gucetic family, it is today the finest example of Croatian landscape architecture. The park has a typical layout of Renaissance garden with grottoes and ancient ruins, summer residence, aqueduct, mill, fountain with Neptune and nymphs and the belvedere pavilion overlooking the sea and islands

**Duration:** Half day excursion (approx. 4 hours)

**Included:** Services of English/French/Dutch speaking private driver, pick up and drop off in front of your hotel, free time and walk in botanical garden.

## DUBROVNIK PANORAMA

Dubrovnik town panorama drive with multiple photo stops. Great panoramic stop near Dubrovnik Old town, enjoy the wonderful overview of Dubrovnik Old town “the pearl of the Adriatic”. Free time in Dubrovnik historical centre.

## KORČULA ISLAND

Korčula town on Island korčula has a rich history. There is evidence which suggests that the Romans first settled on this island as early as the 3rd century BC. The Greeks inhabited the island 2000 years ago and after centuries of turbulence the Venetians introduced stability in the 15th century. Korčula, hometown of Marco Polo, famous stonemasons, shipbuilders and seafarers. Experience the narrow streets, beautiful churches and magnificent palaces in one of the best preserved medieval towns in the Mediterranean. On the return trip a stop can be made in one of the wine cellars of peninsula Pelješac.

**Duration:** Full day excursion

**Included:** Service of English/French /Dutch speaking private driver, pick up and drop off in front of your hotel, ride along the coastline, peninsula Pelješac, free time in historical centre of Korčula town.



## DUBROVNIK COUNTRY SIDE & CAVTAT

The Konavle valley is a fascinating region in the hinterland of Dubrovnik. Known for its traditional way of living, pure olive oil, vineyards, green honey, sweet smelling herbs and embroidery, Konavle is a real ethnographic and natural jewel of Croatia. We suggest an optional drink or lunch near the river Ljuta, the location of the most attractive restaurant in the Konavle valley – the Konavoski Dvori. A visit to Cavtat should not miss. Cavtat, the most southern town of Croatia, a mix of old and new architecture was originally a Greek settlement called Epidaurus.

Today Cavtat is an important holiday resort.

## MONTENEGRO & BAY OF KOTOR

Pelješac the second large peninsula of Croatia, wonderful Mediterranean vegetation, blue green coves, vineyards, small villages and typical old stone houses. Pelješac vineyards offers fine wines, much more than just a drink.
